**Rest of network:** You will not always be permitted to take your bike with you, or an extra fee may be payable. Please check with the relevant transport company before travelling.

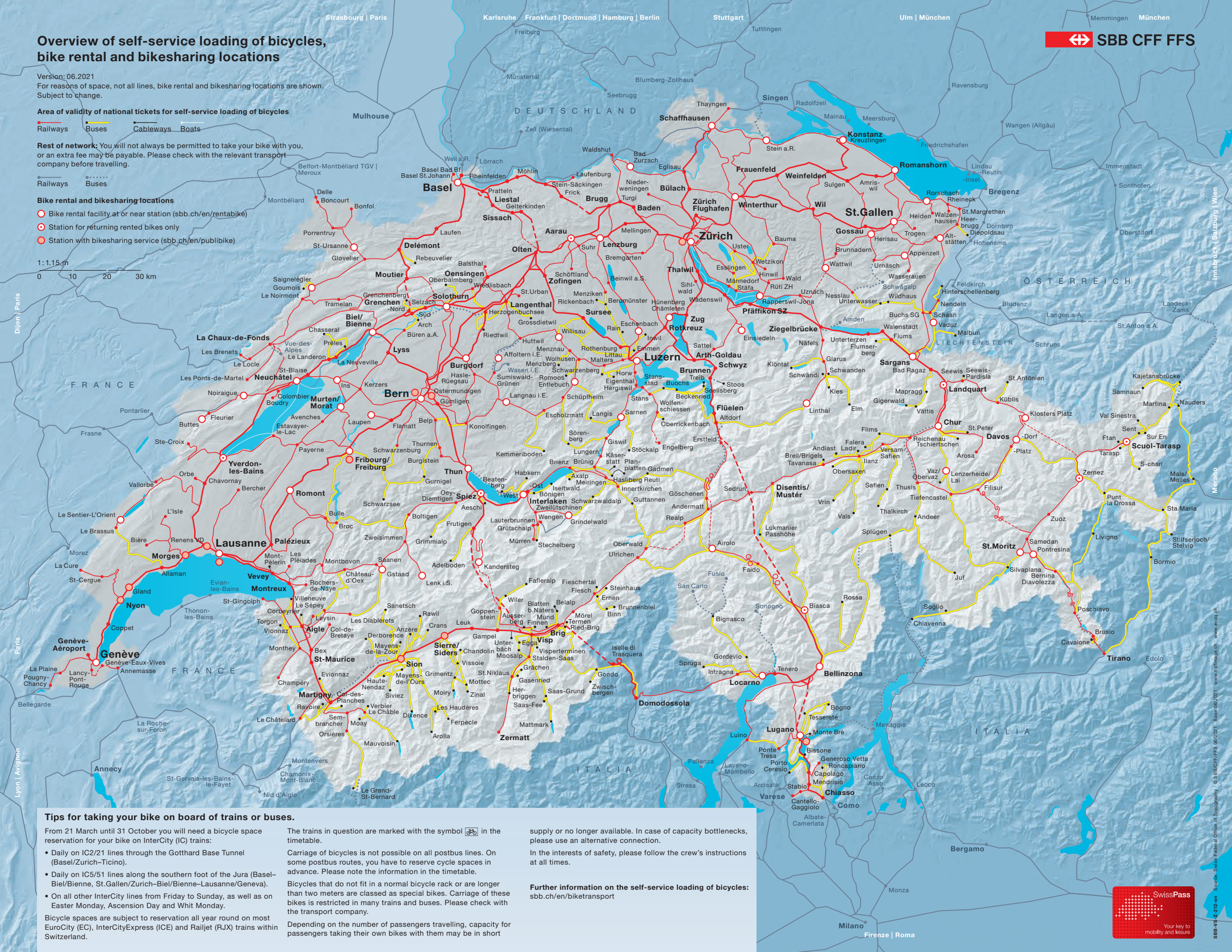

## Tips for taking your bike on board of trains or buses.

From 21 March until 31 October you will need a bicycle space reservation for your bike on InterCity (IC) trains:

- Daily on IC2/21 lines through the Gotthard Base Tunnel (Basel/Zürich-Ticino).
- Daily on IC5/51 lines along the southern foot of the Jura (Basel-Biel/Bienne, St. Gallen/Zürich-Biel/Bienne-Lausanne/Geneva).
- On all other InterCity lines from Friday to Sunday, as well as on Easter Monday, Ascension Day and Whit Monday.

Bicycle spaces are subject to reservation all year round on most EuroCity (EC), InterCityExpress (ICE) and Railjet (RJX) trains within Switzerland.

The trains in question are marked with the symbol in the timetable.

Carriage of bicycles is not possible on all postbus lines. On some postbus routes, you have to reserve cycle spaces in advance. Please note the information in the timetable.

Bicycles that do not fit in a normal bicycle rack or are longer than two meters are classed as special bikes. Carriage of these bikes is restricted in many trains and buses. Please check with the transport company.

Depending on the number of passengers travelling, capacity for passengers taking their own bikes with them may be in short

supply or no longer available. In case of capacity bottlenecks, please use an alternative connection.

In the interests of safety, please follow the crew's instructions at all times.
