- If possible, eyes open and not covered
- Monochrome background
- Even illumination (no shadows)
- Sharp and high-contrast
- Format approx. 35 × 45mm
- No scanned or home-printed paper photos

4 Medical confirmation to obtain a Companion Travelcard.

- Only people with a serious impairment – which is likely to be permanent and, according to medical judgement, cannot be expected to improve significantly in the foreseeable future – are entitled to a Companion Travelcard. People who are likely to be able to travel unaccompanied again in a few weeks or months are not entitled to a Companion Travelcard.
- With the free Companion Travelcard, people with an impairment and/or a guide/assistance dog can be accompanied on public transport by someone else for free within the Half Fare Travelcard area of validity.

I hereby confirm that the person named above is dependent on a companion and/or a guide/assistance dog in order to travel independently by public transport in the long term. It is not possible for this person to obtain travel information, reach platforms and vehicles, purchase tickets or access other services required for travel without a companion.

5 Period of validity and comments.

The **Companion Travelcard** is valid for ten years. After ten years, a **new** application with medical confirmation can be made to obtain a new Companion Travelcard. The holder of the Companion Travelcard will be reminded to apply for the renewal before the current Companion Travelcard expires.

This application with medical confirmation to obtain a Companion Travelcard is valid for six months from the date of issue. This form will be destroyed once the Companion Travelcard has been issued. In the event of a dispute, a second application with medical confirmation from another doctor to obtain a Companion Travelcard may be requested.
