Area of validity of national tickets for self-service loading of bicycles

Reservation is compulsory on the Zerne-Punt la Drossa-Mals (1) and Müstair-Tirano (2) routes.

Rest of network: You will not always be permitted to take your bike with you, or an extra fee may be payable. Please check with the relevant transport company before travelling.

Additional information on the area of validity of national tickets for self-service loading of bicycles.

PostBus Switzerland Ltd.: Valid within the entire network. There are restrictions, however. For details, please go to postbus.ch.

Zürich Transport Network (ZVV): Zurich city transport services. Winterthur town bus services (except at rush hour), regional bus lines (including postbuses but excluding local bus services), other railways (Polybahn, Dolderbahn and Sihltal Zürich Uetliberg Bahn, except for Waldegg-Uetliberg) and boats (Lake Zurich boat network, Horgen-Meilen ferry, Greifensee boats).

Otten town bus services: whole network.

Chur town bus services: whole network and longer-distance services.

RBS/BSU: whole bus network.

TransN: Neuchâtel city network and all other lines. Le Locle and La Chaux-de-Fonds city networks.

Bus Ostschweiz: Buchs and Wil (St.Gallen) city networks.

Rest of network: Please check with the relevant transport company before travelling.

Tips for taking your bike on board trains or buses.

Mandatory bike space reservation (from 21 March to 31 October) on InterCity trains (IC) travelling through the Gotthard Base Tunnel and on all InterCity tilting trains (ICN). You can make reservations easily while on the move by using SBB Mobile app on your smartphone.

On Zurich S-Bahn trains you can only take your bike with you between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. and between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. Monday to Friday. On Saturdays and Sundays there are no restrictions.

For space and safety reasons, you are not permitted to transport tandems, recumbent bicycles, tricycles and other bicycles longer than two metres in IR, IC, ICN and EC trains operated by SBB.

Depending on the number of passengers travelling, capacity for passengers taking their own bikes with them may be in short supply or no longer available.

In case of capacity bottlenecks, please take a later train or one of the additional trains laid on during peak periods, or travel by an alternative route.

In the interests of safety, please follow the train crew's instructions at all times.
